Annuals

- Oxalis 'Copper Tones' with chartreuse and copper colored leaves and Oxalis 'Zinfandel' with deep wine-colored leaves make great fillers.
- Verbena 'Corsage Peach' has huge, DOUBLE peach colored flowers.
- Cleome 'Linde Armstrong' only grows to 15 inches and has deep rose flowers.
- Thunbergia 'African Sunset' is a vigorous vine with antique peach tone flowers.
- Euphorbia cotinifolia is a red leafed tropical shrub for large containers.
- Pennisetum 'Red Bunny Tails' is a grass with green leaves and plump red flowers.
- Fuchsia 'Autumnale' is a trailing type with gold and orange foliage. **Wow!**

Yellow Butterfly Magnolia

Did you know that the yellow flowered magnolia tree Magnolia 'Yellow Butterflies' is one of the finest flowering trees for our area? It blooms much later than the saucer and star magnolias thus avoiding flower scorching late frosts. 'Butterflies' gets 18-20 feet high and wide. Its lemon-colored blossoms perch gracefully at the end of every branch.
