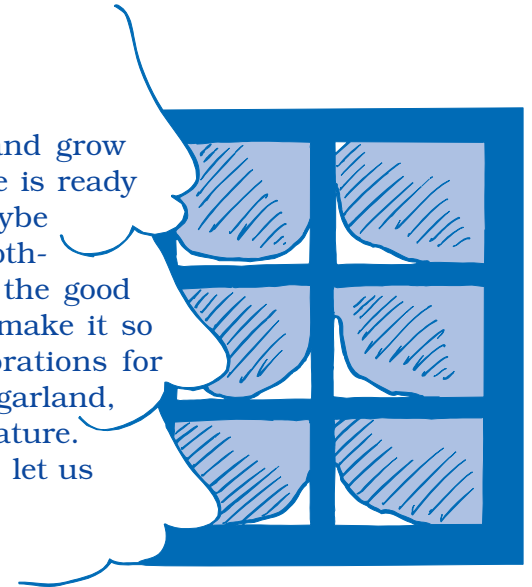

Keep Warm with Firewood

Timberline Gardens has been working hard all summer to have the best selection of firewood available for you. With the cost of natural gas many homeowners are using the woodstove or fireplace to reduce the energy bill.

Oak firewood is still the best value. Oak produces about 29 million BTU per cord as compared to ponderosa pine which produces about 16 million BTU per cord. A lot of folks invested in high effi-



ciency wood stoves during the Y2K scare and now are glad they did. A typical firewood order is 1/4 cord of pine for kindling and 1 cord of oak for the best heating. For a fragrant, romantic fireplace fire, it's hard to beat piñon pine. It is longer burning and smells great!

If you are a chef, try our fruit woods, hickory or mesquite. Chefs metro-wide prefer our hardwoods.

Winter Landscape Care

Last winter taught us all a good lesson about how important winter watering is. We had virtually no precipitation between January and April and many gardeners had tremendous losses of younger trees and shrubs. Almost everyone had damage to turf grass. Mites thrive on sunny slopes and on the sunny sides of trees and buildings. When we have no moisture the mites thrive. Rain washes them away!

To avoid similar problems this winter, try to water at least once a month, especially on younger trees and shrubs. Water turf grass once or twice a month, especially those sunnier, drought prone areas.

You just can't find fresher Christmas trees than the ones at Timberline Gardens. We are well known for our native cut **concolor fir** trees which are far and beyond the longest lasting cut trees you'll find anywhere. We receive concolor firs from southern Colorado's mountains as well as from plantations in Michigan. The native firs have layered branches ideal for old-fashioned heavy ornaments. The plantation firs are bushier and outcompete any other plantation tree for fragrance and longevity. Our customers who have tried the concolors ALWAYS come back for more.

Our other most popular cut tree is the **Fraser fir**. Its deep green, fragrant needles can't be beat for that traditional Christmas tree look. Also northern grown, Frasers will hold up very well compared to other species. We sell more Frasers than any other variety.

When you walk into Timberline's tree lot, you'll notice something different. All of our Christmas trees are standing up in water! Most other tree lots are on sunny, windy parking lots where the trees dry out very quickly. If they get their trees from the NORTHWEST, they aren't tough enough to stand up to our dry air so when you take it home, the tree quickly fades. If you haven't been happy with your trees in the past, try one from Timberline Gardens.

New Christmas Tree Watering System

The hottest thing this year in the live Christmas tree realm is a new automatic watering system called the **Ever-Green Watering System**.

The reservoir is shaped like a Christmas present and has a tube that goes to the tree stand to keep it full. It's much easier to fill the "present" than to reach under the tree and beyond the gifts to see if the tree needs water. How many times have you let a tree go dry only to find the needles falling off in a few days? For \$19.95 you can buy this little bit of insurance and not have to worry.

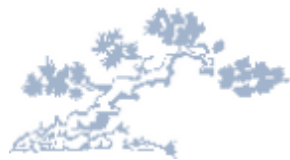
Every year more and more people buy live, potted Christmas trees. We offer various pines and spruce trees from three feet to eight feet high. We recommend that you keep your new tree outdoors until just before Christmas. Then, bring it inside for only a few days. Place it back outside in a sheltered spot when temperatures are above freezing. Plant it in the ground as soon as possible. If appropriate, dig the planting hole in advance of the holidays before the ground is frozen. Cover the hole with a piece of plywood so that no one falls in! Now you can enjoy your tree for years to come.
